

May the God of hope fill you with joy and peace in your faith, that by the power of the Holy Spirit, your whole life and outlook may be radiant with hope. Romans 15:13 Today is the Feast of Pentecost: a commemoration of the strange event that took place 50 days after Jesus' resurrection when the Apostles experienced a powerful rushing wind, a vision of little flames, and an inspired ability to be heard in foreign languages (Acts 2:1-5). It marked a new chapter of God's work in the world as the Holy Spirit was charging a new generation

of believers to lead a new community of holy people: the Christian church.

Some biblical scholars suggest that while some of Jesus' disciples were old enough to marry, others were as young as teenagers. In the Apostle Peter's sermon that Pentecost morning he guoted an Old Testament prophet, "Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your young men will see visions" (2:17). Was he was looking at a crowd of young faces as he said those words?

This Pentecost we celebrate six young people in our church (noted in the graphic) who have completed Confirmation. After three years of in-depth study, prayer, and public declaration of faith, these sons and daughters are not preparing to be the church of tomorrow but are the church of today. They will preach to us in their testimony and lead us in confessions of faith as they are with this church's love and prayer for a lifetime of discipleship.
